

## GAC ISSUE FLOWCHART

Who can bring an issue?  
An issue can come from a board member, from a member of the Chamber of Commerce, or from a committee or task force



Request to be placed on agenda of Government Affairs Committee



Address 14 point Issue Assessment Criteria and present to GAC



At presentation, a vote will be taken on whether to take the subject on as an official issue.  
If vote is **NO** – the issue is dropped, if vote is **YES** – an issue manager is appointed



The issue manager coordinates information to be presented at meetings to fully discuss and explore



Recommendation is made to GAC for action of advocacy in the form of a motion



Vote on level of advocacy



After decision of advocacy, an action plan is developed and followed



With all issues, the Chamber Chairman of the Board serves as spokesperson



Issue and advocacy level is placed in the Business Issues and Advocacy Guide for future reference
