



## Commitment to Ambassadorship

In accepting a position as Ambassador of the Yuba-Sutter Chamber of Commerce, an Ambassador recognizes that with this position comes a commitment to support the organization, its programs and policies and to do all that he/she can do to develop and maintain high standards.

### To be an Ambassador requires:

- Attendance at monthly Ambassador meetings. Missing two (2) consecutive meetings without being excused will be considered as having resigned.
- Notification of excused absence must be in writing (e-mail or fax) in advance (whenever possible) to Ambassador Chair or Membership Director.
- Attendance at 50% of the Ribbon Cuttings that are scheduled each month.
- Attendance at 50% of the Business After Hours or Rise & Shines. An Ambassador must work at least one (1) shift as a greeter or ticket seller.
- \$12/year dues, paid within first month of commitment.
- Become familiar with all Ambassador materials so that he/she can help make effective decisions.
- Serve on at least one (1) committee of his/her choosing or as may be requested by the Ambassador Chair.
- Communicate with the membership to inform them of Chamber activities and programs.
- Attend Chamber networking events as a Chamber representative.
- Being a member or an employee of a member of the Yuba-Sutter Chamber of Commerce.
- Help in representing the Yuba-Sutter Chamber of Commerce at various other community activities.

### An Ambassador will not:

- Get involved in day-to-day management
- Interpret policy in self-interest
- Set policy as an individual
- Speak for the Chamber
- Sign contracts
- Legally and/or financially obligate the Chamber
- Use the position for personal gain
- Usurp the authority of the Executive Director / CEO.
